<b>Welcome, Governance, Draft Minutes &amp; Matters Arising</b>	The Chairperson welcomed the group. No governance or conflicts of interest were declared. Minutes were proposed and adopted. Summary of minutes to be published on NCCA website.
<b>Overview of current draft and TY DG Brief</b>	Education Officer recapped the nature of the work to date, relating it to research, the technical form of the TY PS and the brief from Council.  The DG was divided into two groups and tasks in relation to the student dimensions and curriculum dimensions were outlined. The group undertook the tasks, bearing in mind coherence, supports for enactment and consultation feedback. Feedback from the group was sought and noted by the EOs.
<b>Discussion points from subgroup</b>	The subgroup were invited to give feedback based on their discussions which was noted by the EOs.
<b>Recommendations for successful enactment</b>	The DG made a number of recommendations for successful enactment which were noted by the EO's and are to be collated for presentation.
<b>Additional Items</b>	A number of discussions occurred in relation to the changes from the TY Programme (1993) to the current draft TY PS.
<b>Nature of the Consultation process</b>	The EOs presented the consultation timeline. The DG considered the nature of the consultation and identified modes of engagement.
<b>Reflection and Next Steps</b>	The Chair ended the meeting with a reflection exercise on the groups ' <i>Working Together</i> ' document. The group affirmed the efficiency and transparency of the process, and the quality of deliberations. Next meeting Oct-Nov 2023, details to be confirmed. Draft TY PS to be circulated to the DG for final comments before mailing and presenting to the Board for Senior Cycle and Council.
