### Assessing Key Skills


Allows Teacher to Assess Key Skills of:

- Managing myself Is the student reflecting on her own learning? Is she setting learning goals?
- Information and Thinking Is she gathering, recording, organising, and evaluating information and data?
- Keeping well Am I giving her continuous positive feedback?
- Working with others Is she working well at peer assessment and group work?
- Being Creative Is she looking at options and alternatives and implementing these?
- Is she using ICT to improve learning and communicate with me?

- Mid November, Mocks and May
- New report template
- Adding of on-going and summative assessment
- Quantitative feedback & Qualitative feedback
- Learning advice teacher gives learning feedback on exam and key skills based on 2 stars and a wish
- Assessment of Literacy
- Teacher/student/parent dialogue about learning
- Moderation
- Self-evaluation Learning goal for next term requested



### What have we learned?

- The whole focus must be on learning
